Simpra Advantage is a Medicare Advantage plan that is unique as it is sponsored by local providers and will be offered to long term residents of skilled nursing facilities. Currently Simpra Advantage has over 100 SNF participating in their network with significant growth anticipated. Simpra does not compete with existing MA plans as its focus is on expanding primary care to individuals receiving long term care services. They support utilizing primary care providers, nurse practitioners, and care managers working together within a highly integrated model of care specifically oriented to individuals receiving long term services.. CMS approval is currently in process with marketing for this plan beginning in October 2017 and an anticipated starting date of January 1, 2018. Practice updates – It is very important to report any changes in your practice including office address, mailing address, phone / fax numbers, and current providers with your practice. Timely updates help to reduce claims payment delays or denials, as well as pre-certification issues.

Allied Health Professionals & Physician Extenders – NAMCI credentials allied health and physician extenders. The application can be downloaded from the website or by requesting from the NAMCI customer service team. There is a one-time fee of \$75 to credential these providers.

Re-credentialing – All providers and facilities are re-credentialed every 3 years. A letter with re-credentialing forms will be sent to your office approximately six months from the due date. Please complete timely to avoid suspension of your participation with our network.
